



The “No Clip Left Behind” Act

Henceforth this day, no holiday lighting mounting clips may be left upon the grounds of any client’s (commercial, residential, or otherwise) property in an unused state for properly affixing said holiday lighting to gutters, or rooflines.

Strewn, and abandoned clips are viewed as trash, whether in good working condition, or in post-service life non-functional status. Clips left, whether purposefully, or unintentionally, left behind have become a leading complaint of clients in past years, both after installations, as well as removals. A watchful eye should be placed upon the premises before exiting a property to ensure proper disposal of all clips and any other trash produced by a Chilly Lighter’s activities.
